Gy Gii Kenda Maasii Dodem, (I don't yet know my Clan Name.)



The last year or two, I have managed to attend a few,

Fire, but also what each grandfather stone represents,

The poles, placement of the structure and really how to

Run the sweat in a safe and welcoming way. It has been one of

Most healing portions of my reconnection journey, cleansing as well and bringing

Balance to areas in my Medicine wheel that had been neglected for a long time.

Everywhere I go, i come across things that make me think. I take pictures and record sounds and sometimes just listen and wait in silence to see what happens.

This is just outside my window, but I have hard drives full of things like this waiting to be shared or used for projects like this. One good reason for technology and integrating it into our ceremonies and teachings, there's no reason why we can't now record our stories to be preserved for the future generations. If we do it ourselves, then we have keep our sovereignty over our data.

Even the difference between a digital Camera and a roll of film, I went to the Grand Canyon years ago, in one afternoon, I think I took over a thousands pictures.

I think we were camping when I took this picture. I was given my spirit name by a Cree Elder for up in Northern Quebec.

I am still working to get it translated into my own Dialect, Plains Cree.

But the way he explained it to me is described just like this picture: The space between the Trees and an Opening in the sky.

The translation in my Intro is something I got a little help with, but doesn't quite do it justice.




Somewhere Outside Sault Ste. Marie - July.2022

!! Food Sovereignty in the North!!


I used to belong to a couple of facebook groups that were created to help families in the territories and remote communities by sponsoring them and sending care packages and food.

I suggested that may instead of sending one cardboard box to a single family, maybe we could fill a container with enough supplies to be reused, like rain barrels, and building materials, eventually turning that container into a small home. I was immediately kicked out that group.


Like an Emu.

#Water is Life -


I have had a few life changing experiences with water over the years,

One of them was a few years ago when we travelled to Cuba. We went on a whim, sort of last minute, not that we could really afford it, but we all needed a break and time to relax.



Tipi - Pole Teachings


